"Laws Related to Students and Teachers"

In addition, Adv. Patil informed the audience about an important update regarding the Maharashtra Police helpline number, which has been changed from "100" to "112". He explained how the new number operates and its broader application in emergency situations, ensuring that both students and teachers are equipped with vital safety information.

The session proved to be highly effective and informative, providing valuable legal insights to all attendees. The lecture concluded with a formal vote of thanks proposed by Mr. Abhijit Pawar, who expressed gratitude to the chief guest, organizers, and participants for making the event a success.
