**Topic: Competitive Examination**


**Resource Person: Mr. J. R. Yadav, Dept. of Microbiology, Y.C.I.S., Satara**

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### ***Day 2: 22 October 2021***


#### ***Session I - Topic: Student Welfare and Personal Problems***

The session was concluded by Ms. Neha Bendre.


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### *Session III*

***Chief Guest: Dr. Vandana Nalawade, Principal, Azad College of Education, Satara.***


