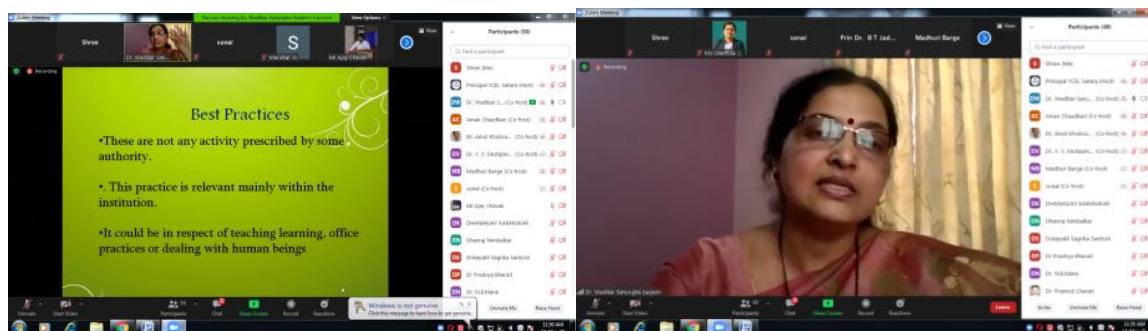


One Day Teacher Training on “Best Practices in Higher Educational Institutes”

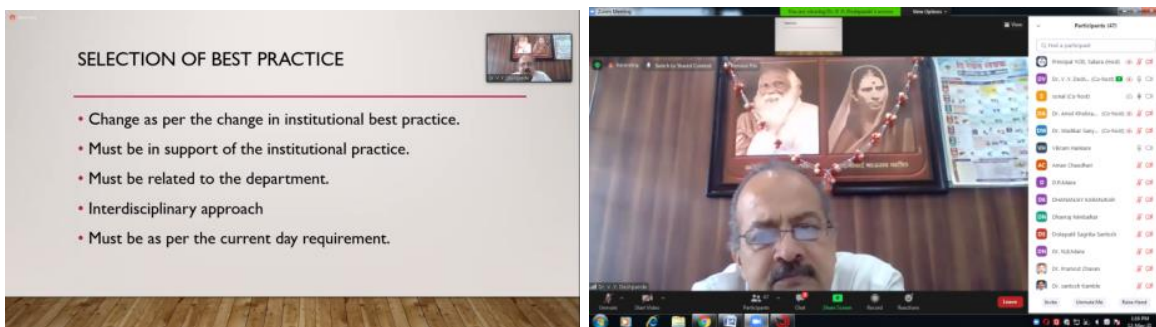

For the First session on Best Practices are institutional quality index Ms Sharmila More introduced the resource person Dr.S.S.Wadikar, Associate Professor, Department of Microbiology. In her speech she mentioned that Best Practices are institutional quality index which are considered by NAAC for benchmarking of institutes and focused on the importance of social and scientific approach along with competitiveness in implementing best practices. She affirmed that best practice is the aggregate of all activities implemented by institutions. She provided 4I and 1D (Identification, Implementation, Institutionalization, Internalization and Dissemination) stages of applications of best practices. Further she provided guidelines for presentation of best practices.

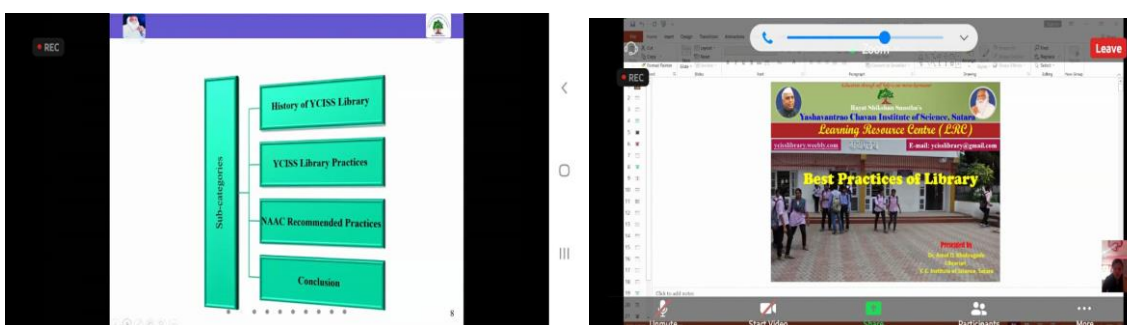
